4.	Review three current job openings for position in your desired industry. List the skills and requirements for these positions.
5.	Search on Google for online career portfolios. What do you like the about examples you see?
6.	What headers do they use that could be applicable to your online portfolio? What color combinations do you like and why?
	FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO GET STARTED
	Create or revise your resume. Trying to make a career portfolio without an updated resume is nearly impossible. <i>You</i>

can omit your address on your career portfolio for privacy purposes.

Brainstorm and write down the categories (headers) you want to include. This information should be related to your career goal. Common headers include, but are not limited to, the following: About Me, Resume, Projects, Presentations, Volunteer Work, and Recommendations.

Choose a free template on Wix and begin working. You can always state "Work in Progress" at the bottom of any section (i.e. if you have one or two projects to list, list them! Don't wait. You can always add more later).

Save your work frequently.

Be sure to proofread and have friends, family, and/or the CREW Staff review your presentation before publishing.
