SUPPLEMENTAL DISABILITY ETIQUETTE

- When helping a visually impaired person, identify yourself before anything else. Do not touch the person's service animal if one is present. If you do in fact guide the person, be very explicit in your directions. For example, if there is a step coming, tell the individual, "there is a step about 6 inches high in 4 walking steps."
- When helping a person with hearing impairments, it is important to follow the cues of the person to see what his/her preferred method of communication is whether it is writing, sign language or lip reading. Also, if signing, make direct eye contact with the individual and, if they are lip reading, avoid chewing gum or obscuring your mouth with your hand.
- For people in wheelchairs, do not push their chair unless asked. Also, do not touch their chair and always be mindful of their personal space. Lastly, sit next to them while addressing them instead of standing over them.
