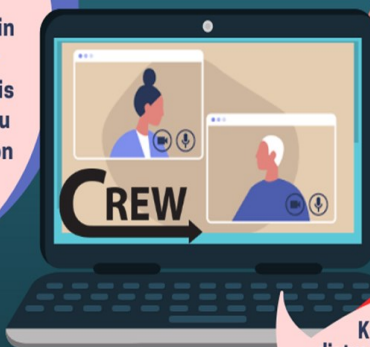

Remote Interview Tips
